General Community Guidelines

RENTAL AGREEMENT: The duration of your rental agreement is specified in the lease. Early termination or extension must be discussed with Property Management.

PETS: No pets are allowed; however, service animals are welcome. If you have a service animal, they must be registered.

KEYS: As stated in your lease, you are responsible for the safekeeping of your keys. Upon move-in, you will receive two keys. For the replacement of lost keys, you must submit a maintenance request. A \$25 fee will be charged for the replacement of unit keys.

VEHICLE PARKING: Street parking is not allowed at any time. Parking is available in the adjacent Damar Services lot. Please park at your own risk.

GUESTS: Overnight guests are welcome. Any guest(s) staying longer than 14 days will require approval.

NOISE: The Damar Village follows the Marion County noise ordinance. As such, quiet hours will be from 10 pm to 7 am daily. Should you have a noise complaint, please email village@damar.org.

WEAPONS: No weapons or firearms on the premises.

GRILLS: Grills are not allowed on patios. There are grills placed throughout the community for outdoor cooking. These grills are free for residents to use.

MAIL & PACKAGES: Mail is delivered to the community mailboxes. Packages too large to fit in the mailbox can be collected at the Village Center office.

MAINTENANCE CHECKS: Quarterly maintenance checks will be required. Residents will be notified via email prior to their maintenance review.

ROOMMATE DISPUTES: While we hope all living situations are positive, we understand roommate disputes can sometimes occur. Damar will make every effort to support roommate mediation; however, alternate living arrangements may not be possible due to limited availability and waitlists already in place at the Damar Village.

NOTICE TO VACATE: If you plan to vacate at the end of your lease term, you must submit a notice to vacate at least 30 days prior to your lease expiration date to receive your deposit refund. You must schedule a move-out inspection with the office.



Paying Rent

WHEN IS RENT DUE?

Rent is due on the 1st day of each month. If rent has not been paid after 15 days, a late fee of \$50 will be charged to the resident.


HOW DO I PAY RENT?

Residents can pay rent online in the Resident Portal at www.damarvillage.org. You will need to establish an online account prior to payment. We also accept cash, check, money orders, or cashier's check. Payment can be dropped off in person at Damar Services main desk during business hours (7 am to 7 pm) or sent by mail to:

When paying rent, your name and apartment number should be on the check or money order to ensure you are credited properly.



Village Center Reservation

The Village Center is available to Damar Village residents and the larger Damar community. To reserve the Village Center, please review the online calendar and then fill out your reservation form. We will be in touch to confirm your reservation.

ABOUT THE VILLAGE CENTER:

The Village Center will hold up to 75 people for most events. Amenities of the Village Center include access to our warming kitchen, tables, chairs, AV materials, and more.

VILLAGE CENTER RULES:

- You must be at least 18 years old to reserve the Village Center.
- Food may be brought in but must be supplied by the user.
- No illegal substance will be allowed at any time. Alcohol is not allowed.
- No smoking is allowed in or around Village Center. Smoking is allowed in personal vehicles only.
- After your event, please clean up the kitchen, tear down tables & chairs, clean/disinfect common spaces and put your trash in the dumpster in the cleaning closet. Excess damage or trash left behind could result in a fine of at least \$100.
- Village Center facilities must be vacated by 10 pm.

These rules are not all-encompassing. An additional acknowledgment form must be signed for scheduled events.
